Syracuse EOC Programs

Introduction to Academics	College Preparation
Assists students with meeting the reading and math requirements needed to enroll in Syracuse EOC programs.	This program provides students with a solid foundation of the academic, study and technology skills needed to enter and achieve success in college programs.
English as a Second Language	College Connections Initiative
Assists students improve language skills in order to continue their education and/or enter or advance within the workplace.	The College Connections Initiative helps under-represented and economically challenged residents of Central New York realize their college education dream.
High School Equivalency (Formerly the GED Prep Program)	Hospitality Training
A comprehensive program designed to provide students with the depth of knowledge and skills needed to take the NYS TASC (Test Assessing Secondary Completion). Instructional areas include English, Math, Science, Social Studies and Career Readiness.	This training provides students with 60 hours of soft skills training which will enhance team building, communication and time management skills.
Computer Software Training	Tutoring Center
This program provides students with the keyboarding and computer application knowledge and skills necessary to compete in today's workplace. Instruction includes the Microsoft Office Suite.	Utilize the Tutoring Center to improve skills in math, reading, writing, or test preparation. Computers with internet access are available for academic use, online job searches, or job applications.
Microsoft Office Specialist Certification	ATTAIN Lab
The Syracuse EOC ATTAIN Lab offers training and testing in Microsoft Office 2013 certification, which is the industry-standard for validating an individual's knowledge base in the Office Suite of applications.	The Syracuse EOC ATTAIN Lab provides resources to help students of all levels reach their academic and professional goals – from low-literacy and ESOL, to college preparation, career planning, and Microsoft Office 2013 applications.
Certified Nurse Aide	Health Train - Clinical & Non-Clinical
This program is a 10-week intensive training designed to prepare students for the the NYS Nurse Aide Exam and for an entry-level position within a healthcare facility as a New York State Licensed Certified Nurse Aide.	This program for both clinical and non-clinical healthcare workers will consist of 60 hours of training which includes soft skills training with an emphasis on communication and teambuilding and a site visit to a healthcare facility.
CNA Recertification	Medical Billing & Coding Program
This 2-week course is designed to prepare students whose nurse aide certification has lapsed retake the NYS Nurse Aide Exam. Career readiness skills are also emphasized.
